



2017 Impact Report

It was a fulfilling year for the board and staff at the David C. Copley Foundation in 2017. Our grant payments for the year were in excess of \$5 million; an all-time high for the Foundation, and excludes a \$5 million leadership grant where we partnered with Rady Children's Hospital and other philanthropists to create the region's first pediatric psychiatric emergency department. We strive to make a difference in the lives of those in San Diego County with our grant funding and we believe this new psychiatric emergency department will provide a desperately needed long-term resource for mental and behavioral health services so critical for many children in our community.

In 2017, we continued to expand and grow our grantee base supporting over 134 non-profits in San Diego County and we extended our reach by supporting humanitarian relief efforts in regions impacted by natural disasters in 2017. Grants to organizations that focus on the provision of basic human services, especially those programs and services focused on improving the quality of life of the homeless and other underserved members in our communities, totaled \$1,365,000 and represented the largest portion of our grants this past year. San Diego is blessed with world renowned medical research organizations and medical service providers. We provided over \$1 million to support many of these exceptional institutions making a difference in cancer research, cardiac care and cutting-edge surgical services.

We are pleased to carry on the philanthropic legacy of David C. Copley and his parents, Helen K. and James S. Copley, and to share the impact we are having here in San Diego and beyond. We endeavor to continue supporting organizations which work so hard to improve the quality of lives for the vulnerable members of our San Diego community.
